SITE GOALS

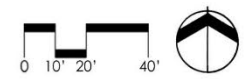
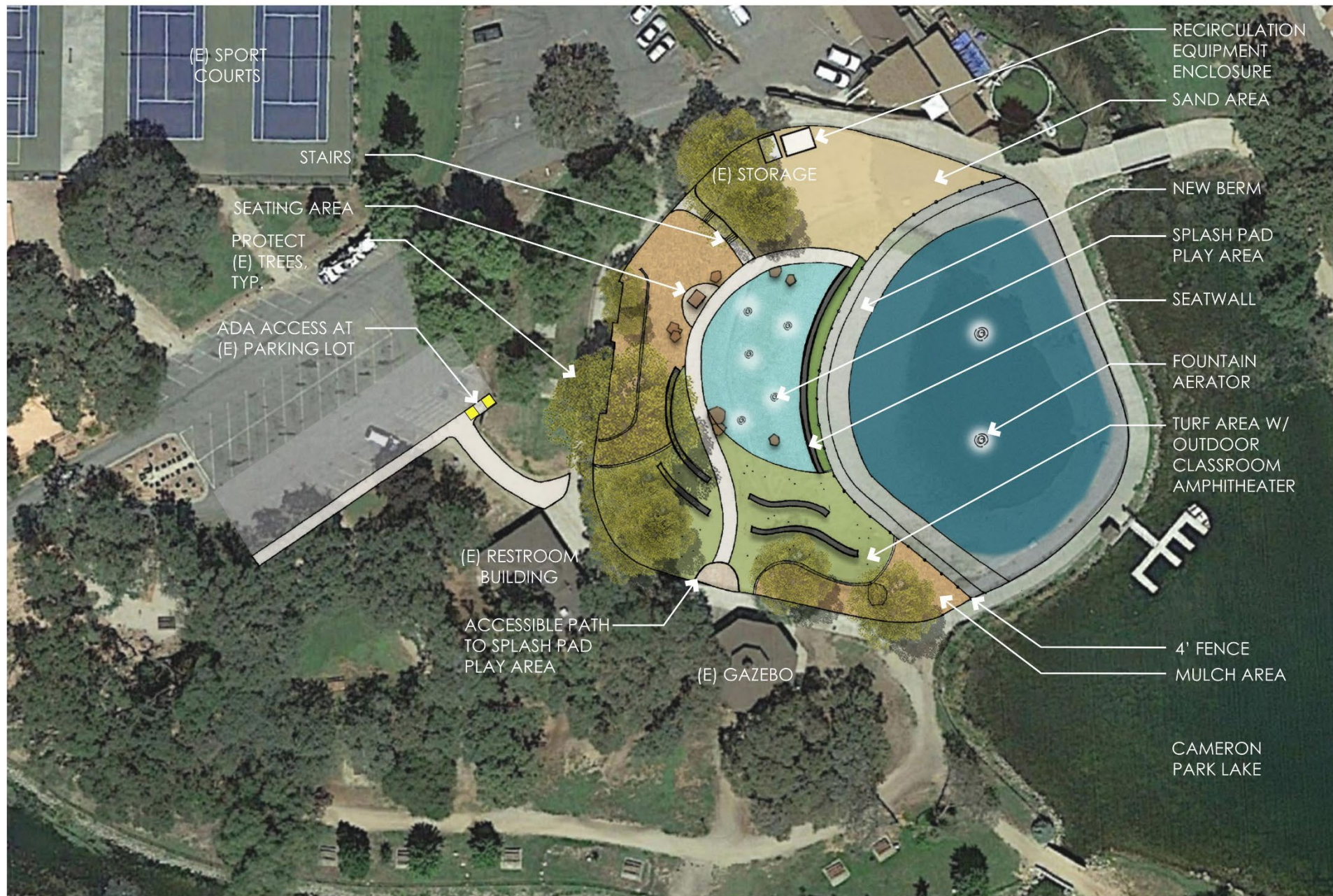
- Convert the existing swimming lagoon to a recirculating splash pad play area to help conserve resources.
