Cameron Park

The community of Cameron Park is located in the foothills of El Dorado County, on the west slope of the Sierra Nevada along U.S. Highway 50, about 30 miles east of Sacramento, California. The community is home to about 18,000 residents and covers an area of about 8.3 square miles. Cameron Park was the 1950s vision of Ruth and Larry Cameron, who purchased the 5,000 acre ranch. The Cameron Park Community Services District (CPCSD) administers fire and emergency services, parks, recreation, covenants, conditions and restrictions (CC&R's), lighting and landscaping, solid waste disposal and recycling.

Cameron Park is a community committed to sustainable growth, while providing access to local and regional education, recreation, healthcare and economic opportunities. Preservation of

our social, cultural and natural resources is the key element for development, planning and stewardship.

The Community Services District

It is the Mission of the Cameron Park Community Services District (CSD) to preserve and enhance the quality of life and to safeguard the health, safety and welfare of our community.

The CSD, for many years, has had the pleasure of serving Cameron Park residents and businesses by providing:

- Fire and emergency services
- Administration services
- CC&R enforcement
- Recreation programs
- Parks and facilities

The CSD also contracts out to supply fire and emergency services and solid waste disposal to the community.



The CSD has a community center and aquatics center as well as a scenic lake and picturesque parks.

It is supported by a five-member elected board which upholds CSD policy as well as providing oversight for new recreational opportunities for residents, business development opportunities for local businesses and facilities for government agencies to gather and meet with residents.

Marketing/Community Outreach Specialist
