If you haven't **recycled your Christmas tree** yet, you may drop it off at Cameron Park Lake, 2989 Cambridge Road, through February 1st. The hours are 7:00 a.m. to dusk. **Boy Scout Troops 700 and 550** will also be picking up discarded Christmas trees from single family homes on Saturday, January 7th, for a suggested donation of \$10 per tree. This money will be used to help support upcoming Boy Scout events and camps. Not every home will be eligible for this pick-up service due to traffic safety, however qualified homes will receive an envelope with complete pick-up details. The trees will be recycled by the CPCSD.
