

Cameron Park Fire Department Operations and Administration Report

- The FY 2023 AFG application period is open through Mar. 8, 2024.
- The FY 2023 SAFER application period is open through Mar. 30, 2024 please note: This is an estimated deadline based on the previous year grant schedule.
- On February 10th, 2024, B2712, E88, and E283 responded to a passenger vehicle fire on Royal Park Dr, within Station 88's first due area. Upon arrival, crews discovered a fully involved full-size pickup truck. The fire was extinguished, and containment efforts successfully limited the damage to the vehicle of origin.
- On February 22, 2024, B2705, E89, and E86 responded to a passenger vehicle fire on Highway 50, within Station 89's first due area. Upon their arrival, firefighters encountered a light-duty boom truck with a fire originating in the cab area. Action was taken to extinguish the flames, and effective containment measures ensured that the fire remained confined to the vehicle of origin.
