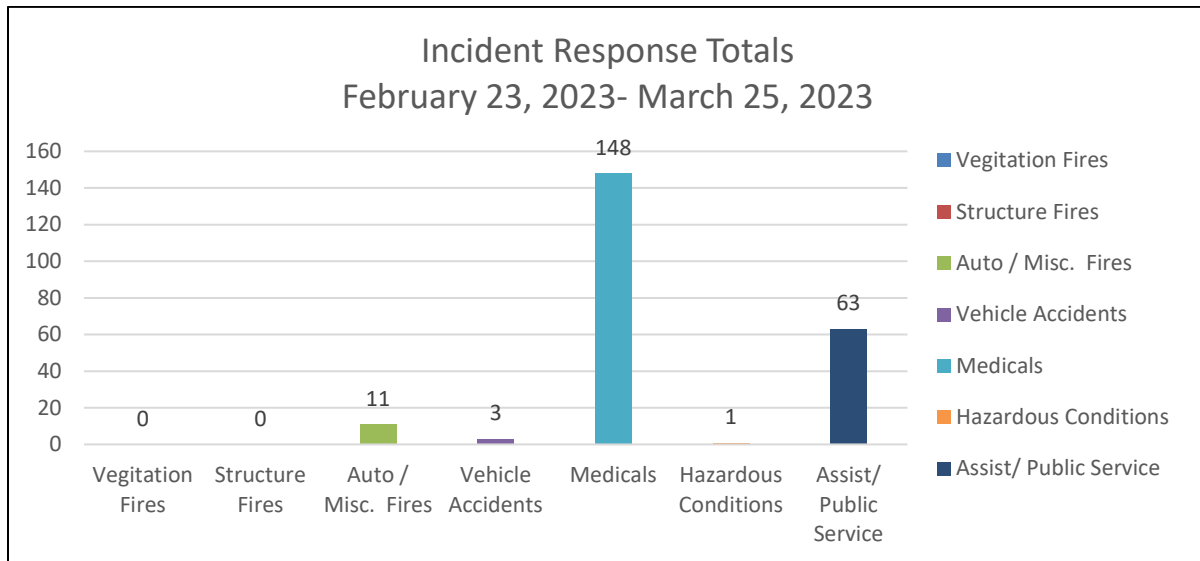

Cameron Park Fire Department Operations and Administration Report

On 5/25/23 Cameron Park promoted FAE/P Greg Schwegler in Cameron to Fire Captain at Station 89.



On 5/25/23 at 0400 B2715, E89, M89, E88, and E28 responded to a vehicle into a structure at Taco Bell. No injuries were reported, and the building received minor damage.



On 5/31/23 B2715, B2710, B2705 E89, E88, M89, E28, E86, and T85 responded to an apartment complex fire at 2600 Knollwood CT. The fire was located in the same complex as the previous fire in November. Engine crews quickly located the fire in the downstairs apartment and extinguished it with no major damage to the building. The fire was contained in the room of origin and is currently under investigation.
