FROM THE PARKS & FACILITIES DEPARTMENT

The Parks and Facilities Department has been hard at work completing some major projects at our parks and facilities! Come and play on the renovated turf grass at Christa McAuliffe Park where you will see various sport camps happening all year long! Or, come to the CP Lake where the District has an 18 hole disc golf course that is open from dusk to dawn seven days a week. The CSD has completed the Solar Panel Project at the Community Center and Fire Station 89. This system will provide all of the District's electrical needs for **BOTH** Parks and Facilities, saving the CSD 1.73 million dollars over 25 years. **WOW!** Last, but certainly not least, the Parks Department is working on the blueprints for the brand new splash pad water feature at the lake!

ADULT AND PEDIATRIC FIRST AID/CPR/AED CLASS:

This course utilizes science and research based content established through the Red Cross. Participants will learn the skills to recognize, respond, and care for a variety of emergencies that may require first aid, CPR, or the use of an AED for adults, infants, and children. This certification will combine videos, lecture, and hands-on skills and online coursework prior to the class. The certification is valid for two years.

LIFEGUARD TRAINING with Title 22 Classes & CSD

Lifeguard Academy: Interested in learning the skills to be a lifeguard? Join our latest lifeguard class. This class teaches Red Cross lifeguarding skills including rescue techniques, CPR, first aid, and more! It will be conducted as a blended learning course with online coursework being completed prior to the first day of class.

Lake & Pool Annual Pass Information

The CSD Annual Pass gives you access to the Lake, Pool and discounts on classes and events at the community pool. They are available for purchase all year long and are valid for one FULL YEAR! **Save 10% with our Early Bird Discount by purchasing between December 1st, 2021 and April 30th, 2022. Already have an Annual Pass? Get the 10% discount when you renew it!** You can purchase your pass online! The Annual Pass grants access to:

CAMERON PARK LAKE

56 acre park filled with an abundance of amenities such as; a 1.1 mile walking path along the shoreline, tennis and Pickleball courts, a playground, horseshoe pits, catch-and-release fishing, an 18-hole disc golf course, picnic and BBQ areas, and restrooms.

THE COMMUNITY POOL

The annual pass is your ticket into the pool for summer recreational swim. In addition, pass holders will save \$2 off lap swim or Aquatic Fitness class reservations and 10% off all Special Events held at the Community Pool.

All the F.A.Q.'s

Q: Why should I buy an Annual Pass?

A: Buying a pass makes access to the lake and pool easy! No cash or credit card is required when you arrive at the CP Lake or when reserving a Rec Swim time at the pool. Revenues generated from the sale of these passes financially support the District's maintenance of Cameron Park Lake and Community Pool.

Q: I am a resident. Why can't I get into Cameron Park Lake for free? Don't my taxes pay for this amenity?

A: Property tax funds are allocated to many different District services including Fire and Emergency Services, Community Special Events and trails. An annual pass is a user fee to offset costs for maintaining the Lake and Pool, two very important community assets.

Q: What are the Lake Kiosk operating hours?

A: Historically, the kiosk has been open late May to early September. With the new Annual Pass Program, the kiosk days and hours will be expanded to more months and weekends throughout the year. Pass holders will save on entry fees at the Lake all year!

Q: Will the Swim Lagoon at CP Lake be open?

A: No... this feature is closed and we are in the process of designing a new water-feature play area we hope to open in Summer of 2022. Check our website for more information.

Q: I am on a fixed income or have a financial hardship, and I can't afford the cost of this pass – is there anything I can do?

A: Yes... Recreation Participant Program Grants are available to residents with a financial hardship. The process can be completed quickly. For full details and an application, please visit our website or scan the QR Code on page 3.

Q: Can I bring my dog to CP Lake or the disc golf course?

A: No... pets are not allowed at Cameron Park Lake due to the wildlife (service animals only). We have many other parks that allow pets on leash, like Gateway Park on Cambridge road; or our off-leash dog park, Paul J. Ryan Memorial Park, on Cameron Park Drive and Hacienda Drive.

Q: My child just wants to play on the playground. The other area playgrounds are free. Why do you charge a fee?

A: Annual Pass revenue helps with overall maintenance of the Lake. You can also use your Annual Pass to swim at the pool. If you aren't interested in the other Lake amenities or the Pool, then you can use one of our other playgrounds at Rasmussen Park, Christa McAuliffe, or Northview. Check out our website for more information and location details.

Q: Does the pass include swim lessons, lap swim and exercise classes at the pool?

A: Pass holders will save \$2 off lap swim or Aquatic Fitness class reservations and 10% off all Special Events held at the Community Pool. Swim lessons are a separate program fee.

HELP FIRST RESPONDERS FIND YOU!

When there is an emergency, the last thing we want to do is waste time finding your address. So help us find you, even on dark nights and smoky days, by following the guidelines below. Plus, it will decrease the probability of your Amazon package going to the wrong house!

For residential homes, all address numbers should be:

- Visible from the street, with no shrubbery blocking them.
- The numbers should be a minimum of 4 inches tall.
- In a horizontal configuration.
- Numbers should be a contrasting color to its background.
- The font should be easy to read (avoid cursive or italicized numbers).

In addition to having your address posted on your home, try using green reflective address signs (found at various local businesses) on your mailbox or posts that are located in front of your home next to the street. These address signs make it easier for first responders to find your home at night.
