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RESOLUTION NO. 97-61

RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING VOTE OF ELECTION,
DECLARING ESTABLISHMENT OF CAMERON PARK COMMUNITY
SERVICES DISTRICT, SETTING FORTH THE BOUNDARIES
OF SAID DISTRICT, THE NAMES OF THE PERSONS ELECTED
DIRECTORS THEREOF AND THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID
DISTRICT IS FORMED

WHEREAS, there has been filed with this Board a petition signed by registered electors within the unincorporated territory described therein equal in number to at least ten per cent (10%) of the number of votes cast within said territory at the general election next prior to the filing of said petition, which petition prays that the territory described therein be organized as a community services district pursuant to the provisions of Title 6, Division 2 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said petition states the proposed name of said district, sets forth the proposed boundaries of said district and states the purposes set forth in Section 61600 of the Government Code for which the district is to be formed, and states the number of members of the Board of Directors of said district to be three (3); and

WHEREAS, following the filing of said petition this Board did at its next regular meeting fix a time and place for hearing said petition, not less than twenty (20) days nor more than forty (40) days after the date of such meeting; and

WHEREAS, notice of the hearing of said petition was published in the manner and for the time required by Sections 61105 and 61106 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, upon the final hearing of said petition this Board of Supervisors did fix the boundaries of said proposed district, and in doing so did exclude from the district all lands

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which would not be benefited by the proposed budget, and did include in said district only such lands as will be benefited thereby; and .

WHEREAS, upon said final hearing this Board did designate as the name for said proposed district "Cameron Park Community Services District"; and

WHEREAS, this Board did on said final hearing call an election to be held not less than forty (40) days nor more than sixty (60) days from the date of said final hearing for the purpose of determining whether or not said district shall be formed and for the purpose of selecting persons who shall serve as the first directors of said district; and

WHEREAS, this Board did cause notice of said election to be published in the manner and for the time required by Sections 61122 and 61123 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said election was duly held and conducted within said proposed district on June 20, 1961, and said election was in all respects conducted and held in the form and manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, this Board, having met this 26th day of June, 1961, to canvass the vote at said election and declare the result thereof, and such canvass having been duly made;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND DECLARED:

1. That said election was held and conducted in all respects and particulars as required by law;
2. That the total number of votes cast in said election at the polling place provided therein was 8; that the number of absentee votes was 0;
3. That the measure voted upon in said formation election and the number of votes received for and against the

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measure are as follows:

4. That the persons voted for at said election to fill the offices of members of the Board of Directors, and the number of votes given to each person running for said offices, respectively, were as follows:

5. That a community services district of the name of "Cameron Park Community Services District" has been duly established, with the boundaries stated in the resolution calling said election, which boundaries are particularly set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference;

6. That ARTHUR J. ENZLER, OLIN S. STINNETT and VERNON R. WING have received a plurality of the votes cast for three (3) members of said Cameron Park Community Services District and are hereby declared elected for the terms to be ascertained according to the provisions of Section 61201 of the Government Code of the State of California;

7. That said Cameron Park Community Services District is formed for the following purposes:

A. To supply the inhabitants of the district with water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation, industrial use, fire protection and recreation.

B. The collection, treatment or disposal of sewage, waste and storm water of the district and its inhabitants.

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C. The collection or disposal of garbage or refuse matter.

D. Protection against fire.

E. Public recreation by means of parks, including aquatic parks and recreational harbors, playgrounds, swimming pools or recreation buildings.

F. Street lighting.

G. Mosquito abatement.

H. The equipment and maintenance of a police department or other police protection to protect and safeguard life and property.

I. To acquire sites for, construct, and maintain library buildings, and to cooperate with other governmental agencies for library service.

J. The opening, widening, extending, straightening and surfacing, in whole or part, of any streets in such district, subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.

K. The construction and improvement of bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains, and works incidental to the purposes specified in subdivision (J), subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.

8. That this resolution and order shall be entered in the minutes of this Board of Supervisors according to the provisions of Section 61127 of the Government Code of the State of California and the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to file certified copies of this resolution and order as statements of the creation of said district with the Recorder of the County of El Dorado, the Assessor of the County of El Dorado, the Secretary of State of the State of California and the State Board of Equalization of the State of California.

9. That the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed on behalf of this Board to issue a certificate of election to each of the successful candidates.
