

ORDINANCE NO. 2026.01.21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CAMERON PARK COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING THE DISTRICT SCHEDULE OF FIRST RESPONDER SERVICE FEE

The Board of Directors ("the Board") of the Cameron Park Community Services District of El Dorado County, State of California ("the District") hereby ordains as follows:

Section I. Purpose and Intent: Pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 13916 et seq., the District is authorized to charge and collect fees to cover the costs of any service which the District provides or the costs of enforcing any regulation for which the fee is charged. It is the purpose and intent of this Ordinance to establish and impose District-wide fees for the delivery of emergency medical services by a fire apparatus of the Cameron Park Fire Department to augment the funding of paramedic fire support services and to upgrade facilities to meet community needs.

Section II. Fee Schedule: The District engaged a Financial Consultant to conduct a comprehensive review of the First Responder Fee using a direct cost of response model to ensure the fee accurately reflects the reasonable and fully burdened costs associated with providing advanced and basic life support services throughout the District. Following completion of the analysis, the Board held a public hearing on January 21, 2026, to consider the proposed First Responder Fee of \$383.39 (subject to annual inflation adjustments), during which all objections or protests were heard and considered. The District hereby adopts the First Responder Fee as determined through the consultant's direct cost model evaluation. The fees incorporated herein shall be adjusted annually by the percentage increase, if any, associated with the Cooperative Fire Protection Services Agreement with CAL FIRE.

Section III. Limited Amendment: If any section or attachment of this Ordinance or portion thereof is held invalid or unenforceable by any court and such judgment becomes final, then that section may be amended by the District's Board by a majority vote to conform to the judgment of such court, provided such amendment is consistent with purpose and intent of this Ordinance.

Section IV. Effective Date and Publication: This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. The Cameron Park Board Secretary is directed to publish this Ordinance as adopted in a newspaper of general circulation in the District. In lieu of publication of the full text of the Ordinance within fifteen (15) days after its passage, a

summary of the Ordinance may be published at least five (5) days prior to and fifteen (15) days after adoption by the District Board and a certified copy shall be posted in the office of the District, and Cameron Park Fire Department Office, pursuant to Government Code Sections 25120 through 25132.


