Many of us are already thinking and planning adventures and home projects. Please remember the following:

Recreational & Trailered Items:

Planning a boat or recreational trailer trip? Make sure your trailered items are not blocking streets, neighbor's driveways, mailboxes, fire hydrants etc. We also need to be aware that we can stage our trailered vehicles for 48 hours in most neighborhoods before and after a trip. Please do not exceed these allowances. Residents complete online complaints that are filed with your property address which will trigger an investigation. These violations stay on your file for as long as you own your home. You can avoid these complaints. When you're done staging, return your trailered items to your storage area. All trailered items including cargo trailers must be stored per your CC&Rs. Your CC&Rs are available on our website.

Architectural Review (ARC):

If you are planning on building storage, adjust fence lines or installing a structure like a shed, gazebo or outdoor kitchen, you need to apply for ARC approval. All exterior improvements or changes to your existing structures require this approval. If you complete a project without ARC approval, you may receive a complaint or violation to correct the project or get your approval at double the review fee. Both will be costly and could result in additional penalties. Applications for your new project are on our website.

Defensible Space is your property's front line defense against wildfire. Creating and maintaining defensible space around your home can dramatically increase your home's chance of surviving a wildfire and improves the safety of firefighters defending your property. 100 feet of defensible space is required by law.*

THREE ZONES MAKE UP THE REQUIRED 100 FEET OF DEFENSIBLE SPACE:

ZONE 0: 0-5 feet of Ember Resistance

- The first five feet from your home is the most important. Keeping the area closest to buildings, structures, and decks clear will prevent embers from igniting materials that can spread the fire to your home.

ZONE 1: 30 feet of Lean, Clean & Green

- Remove all dead plants, grass and weeds.
- Remove dead or dry leaves and pine needles from your yard, roof and rain gutters.
- Keep tree branches 10 feet away from your chimney and other trees.

ZONE 2: 30-100 feet of Reduced Fuel

- Cut or mow annual grass down to a maximum height of 4 inches.
- Create horizontal spacing between shrubs and trees.
- Create vertical spacing between grass, shrubs and trees.

Use Equipment Properly to Keep from Sparking a Wildfire

- Mow before 10 a.m., and never on a hot or windy day. String trimmers are a safer option (vs. lawnmowers) for clearing vegetation.



VERTICAL SPACING

Large trees do not have to be cut and removed as long as all of the plants beneath them are removed. This eliminates a vertical "fire ladder."



HORIZONTAL SPACING

Create horizontal and vertical spacing between plants, the amount of spacing will depend on how steep the slope is and the size of the plants.

DEAD TREE REMOVAL

If you have dead or dying trees on your property, the entire tree needs to be removed to reduce wildfire risk. READYFORWILDFIRE.ORG/DEAD-TREE-REMOVAL

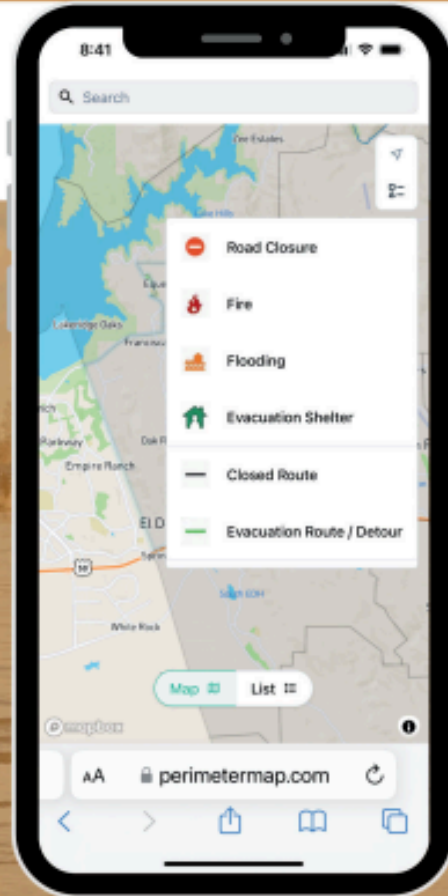
