



The Cameron Park Community Services District, along with the El Dorado County Department of Public Health and the California Department of Public Health, is currently monitoring the rapidly evolving COVID-19 outbreak.

Beginning Saturday, March 14, the Cameron Park Community Center will be suspending operations until further notice, including the pool, classrooms, gymnasium and assembly hall for recreation programs and community gatherings. This step is taken to ensure that the District meets the current local and state mandates to prevent the spread of the COVID 19 virus. Credits or refunds will be coordinated through the District office.

Senior Nutrition meals will continue to be available.

The District office will remain open, but staff encourages residents to conduct business with the office via telephone or email if possible. District Board and Committee meetings will occur but Board/Committee members may coordinate their participation remotely. Guidelines for social distancing will be met for meetings.

The Community Center will remain closed until further notice. The District will continue to follow local and state guidelines and expertise to help ensure the health of our community, and will provide updates to you in a timely manner.
