

The Cameron Park Community Services District, along with the El Dorado County Department of Public Health and the California Department of Public Health, is currently monitoring the rapidly evolving COVID-19 outbreak. The following steps are being taken to ensure that the District meets the current local and state mandates to prevent the spread of the COVID 19 virus

- Beginning Monday, March 16, the Cameron Park CSD Community Center will be closed to the public in order to help "flatten the curve" and slow the spread of COVID-19.
